

THE PINSKE EDGE

#3310 CIRCLE COMPASS

The Pinske Edge Circle Compass may be used for countertops, tables, pinstripes, cleaning off your edge treatment and even making your radius edge treatment.

(The two 5-16 x 24 nuts on the base plate are for fine tuning the finished radius dimension.)

1. For the radius, find the center of the material and scribe a 6" circle.
2. The Circle Compass makes circles from 13" to 90" in diameter and adjusts with only an allen wrench and an open-end wrench.
3. Pump up the cup to the maximum strength and adjust the pre-bent arms so the router base sits flat on the counter top.

Referencing from the inside edge of the router bit, set the Circle Compass at the pivot center to the desired radius.

4. Start with the router raised and rout the entire radius.
5. Move the router in by adjusting the Circle Compass arms to the desired dimension. Rout a perfect radius or pinstripe EVERY time!
